Re this submission to draft Burial and Cremation Bill 2019

In relation to your draft Burial and Cremation Bill 2019 I note there is no mention to “Access to Cemeteries” when they are surrounded by private land (particularly farming land). For a farm to remain viable farming practices are constantly changing, particularly with the introduction of Pivot Irrigators. I am making this submission because I am a farmer and there is a private Cemetery which is surrounded by my property.

#### SUBMISSION TO DRAFT BURIAL AND CREMATION BILL

Where Cemeteries are surrounded by private land the land owner should be required to provide an accessway to the site but that access may change from time to time so that it does not interfere with changing farm practices and such a change should be noted by the appropriate authority.
