Reference your voicemail this morning,
I have been on the phone with the owners and they are pushing to have all the works completed by the end of this week Unfortunately we are not in a position to dictate to the owner who they use to complete their base building works. If was removed from

works completed by the end of this week Unfortunately we are not in a position to dictate to the owner who they use to complete their base building works. If was removed from site and we engage our own contractors then we would need to bear these costs, I believe the process has been slowed down due to an ill family member. The owner has advised that they are prepared to install the overhead cupboards to the kitchenette but this will come at a cost to us of \$1,500 they are also preparing a quote for the window to the meeting room. Perhaps the best approach is to hold off on both these items until you have settled in and determined their necessity, it might be that the remaining budget could be better spent elsewhere?

We are arranging for the removalists to deliver furniture to site this week, I believe waiting on confirmation of some additional items that he sent photos through of last week. Can you advise on these items so we can get it completed in one delivery?

Our painter will be onsite this week to complete works on the front reception counter and the storage unit, due to the work involved he has advised that it will take 3 days.

Orders have been placed for the front blind and also new LED light fittings for the main office area, these will need to be installed once you are in occupation due to lead times.

To date we have expended approximately \$7,518 of the \$15,000 available. There will be approximately \$500 for the removalists and also the cost to demolish the partition to come. From past experience we have found that it's a good idea to move into the office for a few weeks, get settled and then we pop out and see what else is required. The budget is looking very good and there will be plenty of money to put towards other setup items.

Based on the above and to avoid your staff and trades tripping over each other, could we hold off on you officially operating from the office until Monday the 4th of November? There would be nothing stopping you dropping off bits and pieces throughout this week.

We would also like the opportunity to have the office fully cleaned on Friday so it is at an acceptable standard for your occupation.

If you could come back to me ASAP with answers that would be much appreciated.
