

Dog Control Act 2000
sections 5 and 32

Approved collar

For the purposes of sections 5 and 32 of the *Dog Control Act 2000* a collar is of the approved kind if:

- It consists of red stripes alternately spaced with yellow stripes each being of a width of 25mm and set diagonal to the rim of the collar at an angle of 45 degrees; and
- At least one of the two colours reflects light in the dark; and
- It is made of durable materials; and
- It is able to be securely fastened; and
- It has a facility to attach a leash; and
- It has a minimum width of:
 - (1) 25mm for a dog weighing less than 20 kg; or
 - (2) 40mm for a dog weighing between 20 kg and 40 kg; or
 - (3) 50mm for a dog weighing more than 40 kg.
