**Subject:** follow up suggestion for Sustainability strategy

Hi

As a member of the Tasmanian Climate Collective, I was part of a group who made a submission to the Sustainability Strategy "Have your Say" process.

This email is a follow up suggestion from me personally.

I would like to suggest a Tasmanian Commission for Future Generations, similar to the [Welsh model](#), that so many other jurisdictions are emulating. Too many of Tasmania's problems (climate change, housing, health, environment, education, etc.) can be linked to short term thinking. A commission for future generations adds balance to this tendency. It's hard to find an argument against considering future generations.

I've been inspired to make this suggestion following a brief discussion with Cameron McLennan, at a recent public event (Circular Economy Huon). I'm impressed that he has an understanding of this concept, when so few decision makers seem aware of it.

I will be promoting and discussing the idea of a Tas Commission for Future Generations with a number of Tas NGOs. I'm happy to discuss this further with anyone in DPAC.
