- The provision of the ministerial vehicle fleet allows Ministers to work and travel safely as the vehicles are well maintained, and are driven by experienced and qualified drivers.
- Vehicles must satisfy a range of criteria before they can be considered appropriate for use in the Ministerial fleet, including:
  - Being of sufficient size in both the front and rear cabin to allow multiple people to utilise the car as a mobile office.
  - Having sufficient carrying capacity to cater for the luggage requirements of multiple staff, including computer and other equipment.
  - A comfort level appropriate for a vehicle in which Ministers and their staff will be expected to travel for extended periods on government business covering up to 40,000 km per year on a wide variety of roads

The vehicles are also used for a range of other services including services to visiting dignitaries, and official State functions.
