

# Tasmanian Government Card Expenses

A Tasmanian Government Card is a type of payment method and is not a duplication of expenditure. For every transaction made on a Tasmanian Government Card, there is tax invoice and receipt held by the Department of Premier and Cabinet's Financial Management Services.

Appropriate credit card use includes any business-related expenditure such as travel, office supplies and related expenses, and excludes items such as fuel for Government vehicles, cash withdrawals, entertainment (includes meals and alcohol while not travelling, events and related costs) and personal expenses.

The table below outlines expenditure over the six-month period from October 2025 to March 2026 expended on behalf of all Offices.
