BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- Architects were engaged to co-ordinate the fit-out works in consultation with DPAC.
- The total cost, including project management and associated ancillary costs, is \$726 136 for 22 Elizabeth Street and \$147 065 for 134 Macquarie Street.
- The lessor offered a lease incentive payment of \$950 000 to fund these works associated with the move to 22 Elizabeth Street. This was offered on the basis that the lessor had a private sector tenant to move into the space vacated by TMD at 2 Salamanca Square. The surplus funds arising from the work at 22 Elizabeth Street were used to meet the works at 134 Macquarie Street.
