Assessment and actions by Heads of Agency of  
current and former State Service employees referred to  
in the Commission of Inquiry report**

The following additional information is provided to support the Routine Disclosure data published on 20 May 2024.

Of the 22 employees identified by Heads of Agencies as alleged perpetrators:	
Deceased	1
Convicted of criminal charges, which is a matter of public record	2
Terminated through an ED5 process	4
Resigned prior to an ED5 commencing	8
Active ED5 processes underway noting that these employees are suspended	4
Returned to duty following conclusion of ED5 processes	3
Of the total of 22 matters, 4 remain subject to active ED5 processes. All 22 matters have been referred to police and all relevant regulatory authorities.	

Of the 42 non-perpetrator employees identified for assessment by Heads of Agencies:	
Deceased	2
Current employees with active ED5 processes underway	7
Resigned prior to, or during an ED5 process	12
Current and former employees still under assessment	17
Found to have breached the State Service Code of Conduct and received a sanction other than termination	1
Assessed resulting in no further action	3
Of the total of 42 matters, 7 current employees remain subject to active ED5 processes, and 17 assessments are due to be completed.	

Of the 6 current or former employees identified by the Commissioner of Police:

Current or former employees found to have breached the Code of Conduct under the Police Service Act 2003 and received sanctions other than termination	3
Current or former employees assessed as requiring no further action or referral to Professional Standards	2
