d) What proof was required and/or provided for individuals and families to access emergency aid funds;

Applications are required to provide proof of identity and principle place of residence.

e) What criteria were individuals and families required to meet to qualify for funds:

Purpose -

The purpose of the Emergency Assistance Grant is to assist people affected by an eligible natural disaster to obtain essential and appropriate shelter, clothing, food, transport and/or personal items.

The Emergency Assistance Grant is not income tested and is available to all people affected by eligible natural disasters who without assistance would suffer personal hardship and distress.

Criteria -

To qualify for funds, the applicant's principle place of residence had to have been affected/made unfit to live in or inaccessible as a result of an emergency. Proof of identity and principle place of residence was required.

f) Whether or not any individuals or families presented to request emergency aid funds but were refused, if so on what grounds and the number in total.

If an applicant was not eligible or unable to provide adequate evidence to support their claim requests were denied. Information on the number of in-eligible applicants was not recorded.
